THE CANCER FUND COMES TO HEARTLAND CANCER CENTER Golden Belt Community Foundation Answers the Call During Month of October

GREAT BEND, Kan. – October marks National Breast and Liver Cancer Awareness Month. In an outreach effort, Golden Belt Community Foundation will be at Heartland Cancer Center, at 204 Cleveland St., Great Bend, on Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. during the month of October. The goal is to assist with the application process and connect cancer patients to community resources.

The Heartland Cancer Patient Care and Support Endowment Fund with Golden Belt Community Foundation offers grants for shelter, caregiving, nutrition, medical supplies, and

transportation. Sue Cooper, Golden Belt Community Foundation Program Officer stated, "Having cancer is difficult all on its own. On top of medical care, patients soon find themselves overwhelmed by mounting debt. The fund exists to help ease some of those financial burden."

To date, the cancer fund has helped 34 patients by awarding grants topping \$14,300. "The cancer fund has helped in ways we'll never know," Cooper noted. "From middle aged men no longer able to care for their families, to a woman seeking treatment months after losing her husband to the same devastating disease, to patients having no transportation or money for the public bus, to those waiting for disability or at the end of short-term disability and still needing treatment five days a week, and people needing help with the purchase of feeding tube supplements and adult briefs. The list goes on and on."

The foundation encourages patients to visit with Sue Cooper during Cancer Awareness Month at the Cancer Center. Patients will find the application process easy, as the paperwork is limited to only two pages, with no proof of income required.
