To enter simply upload a video explaining why your community project should receive the funding and how it would add *magic* to your community making it a better place.

Video

Record a video that is at least one minute long but no longer than five minutes in length. The video should explain why your project will add some *magic* to your community and how it will make it a better place. The ideal project would involve enhancements that are visible in your community.

All music and sounds must be royalty-free or you must have written permission from the owner to use it in the video for purposes of this contest. Royalty-free music terms and conditions are also the responsibility of the contestant. GBCF is not liable for the video hosting website licenses, terms, and conditions and all people who submit a video are giving GBCF permission to use the video and its content. Multiple people may appear in the video however, you must have permission from each person whose name, image, likeness and/or voice is included in the video entry.

* GBCF board members may not submit a video

* All grants shall be awarded to an eligible grantee, such as a 501(c)(3) organization, unit of government, or religious organization.

Timeline and Judging

The *magical* Mini Grant contest will be accepting video submissions from October 5, 2020 through October 19, 2020. Golden Belt Community Foundation will announce each grant winner on October 26th for each county!
